University Medical Center at Princeton has opened a new Breast Health Center. It is located at East Windsor Medical Commons 2, 300 B Princeton-Hightstown Road, East Windsor.

The new Breast Health Center provides state-of-the-art digital mammography; results the same day for mammograms before 3:00 p.m.; immediate results for all diagnostic mammography; ultrasound of the breast including ultrasound guided and stereotatic biopsies; and breast health education programs. The Center offers convenient office hours including appointments beginning at 7:30 a.m. weekdays; appointments until 7:00 p.m. on Wednesdays; and Saturday appointments.

For women who have been diagnosed with breast cancer, a Nurse Navigator will be available to help guide and support women through the diagnostic and treatment phases.

Rachel Dultz, MD, FACS, board certified in surgery, who specializes in breast surgery, is the Medical Director of the new Breast Health Center.

Dr. Dultz has been on the staff of Princeton HealthCare System since 1998. She is an active volunteer with the Susan G. Komen Race for the Cure and the Princeton YWCA Breast Cancer Resource Center. According to Dr. Dultz, "Women will benefit most from the coordination of care and services. For women with breast cancer, the wait time between being seen, diagnosed and treated will be reduced due to a more streamlined process."

Jeana Oh, MD, a board certified radiologist who completed a fellowship in breast imaging at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center, is the Director of Medical Imaging. She is the lead interpreting physician, just one member of a team of highly qualified physicians at the center.
